Dear Parents and Carers,



I need to say a massive well done to all of our year six pupils for their positive attitudes towards the SATs tests this week. All children respond differently to having to take tests, but I have been so proud of each and every one of them for trying their very hardest and doing the best that they can, especially after the disruptions that they have had to their schooling over recent years. They can now look forward to East Barnby and all the end of term events that are planned.

School attendance

We have recently seen a rise in pupil absences from school and this is having an impact on children's friendships and their learning. The National average attendance is 96% which means that on average most pupils miss no more than 4% of the school year. If your child's attendance falls below this it is a cause for concern, and if their attendance falls below 90% they are classed as a persistent absentee and you may be invited in to school to discuss their attendance and explore options for school to help you improve it.

In the Early years pupils learn phonics and early number - the basic skills that they will need to see them through the rest of their education, if they regularly miss school or arrive late, they will inevitably develop gaps in their learning that become difficult to fill. As they move up through the year groups they build upon this vital knowledge and it is important that poor attendance does not cause them to fall behind. The table below shows the impact that poor attendance can have over their school career.

1 day a fortnight	20 days per year	4 weeks per year	Nearly 1.5 years
1 day a week	40 days per year	8 weeks per year	Over 2.5 years

Punctuality

A similar pattern applies for pupils who are consistently late for school. We tend to teach phonics and spellings first thing the morning, and if your child is regularly late, this will quickly have an impact on their spelling and reading.

Holidays in term time

Headteachers have the discretion to grant leave, but they should only do so in exceptional circumstances. If a headteacher grants a leave request, it will be for them to determine the length of time that the child can be away from school. This leave is unlikely, however, to be granted for the purposes of a family holiday. Parents can be fined for taking their child on holiday during term time without consent from the school.



News from Class 3

It has been a rather different week for class 3 with children in years 4 and 5 being evicted for part of the morning so the Year 6 children could complete their SATs tests. All the children have coped with the inconvenience and additional stress incredibly well and have shown themselves to be incredibly supportive, caring and resilient.

In English this week the children have begun researching trains in preparation for a piece of work linked to our class novel "The Railway Children". Trains have come a long way since this book was written in 1905 and the children have loved finding out about the bullet train, in particular.

Year 5/6 science this week was learning all about the changes humans go through as they age. We particularly enjoyed the baby pictures and looking for features they recognised (Lucy's eyes, Samuel's mouth). Children in Years 3 and 4 were learning all about skeleton and the important job it does.



Finally, our brass lessons are beginning the pay off. The sound the children are making is lovely, especially when Mr Batty plays the jazzy backing, allowing the children to 'freestyle' in places. It sounds amazing! In Computing, the Year 5 and 6's have been using the Crumble programme to light a sparkler.

Mental Health Champions

Mrs Cosstick and the mental health champions have been working incredibly hard on the outdoor classroom to make it a calm and welcoming place to be during playtimes. They have included chalkboards, cushions, books and a large canvas for drawing on. It is lovely in there now and it is being used just how we wanted – as a place to get away from the busy playground and spend some time quietly.
